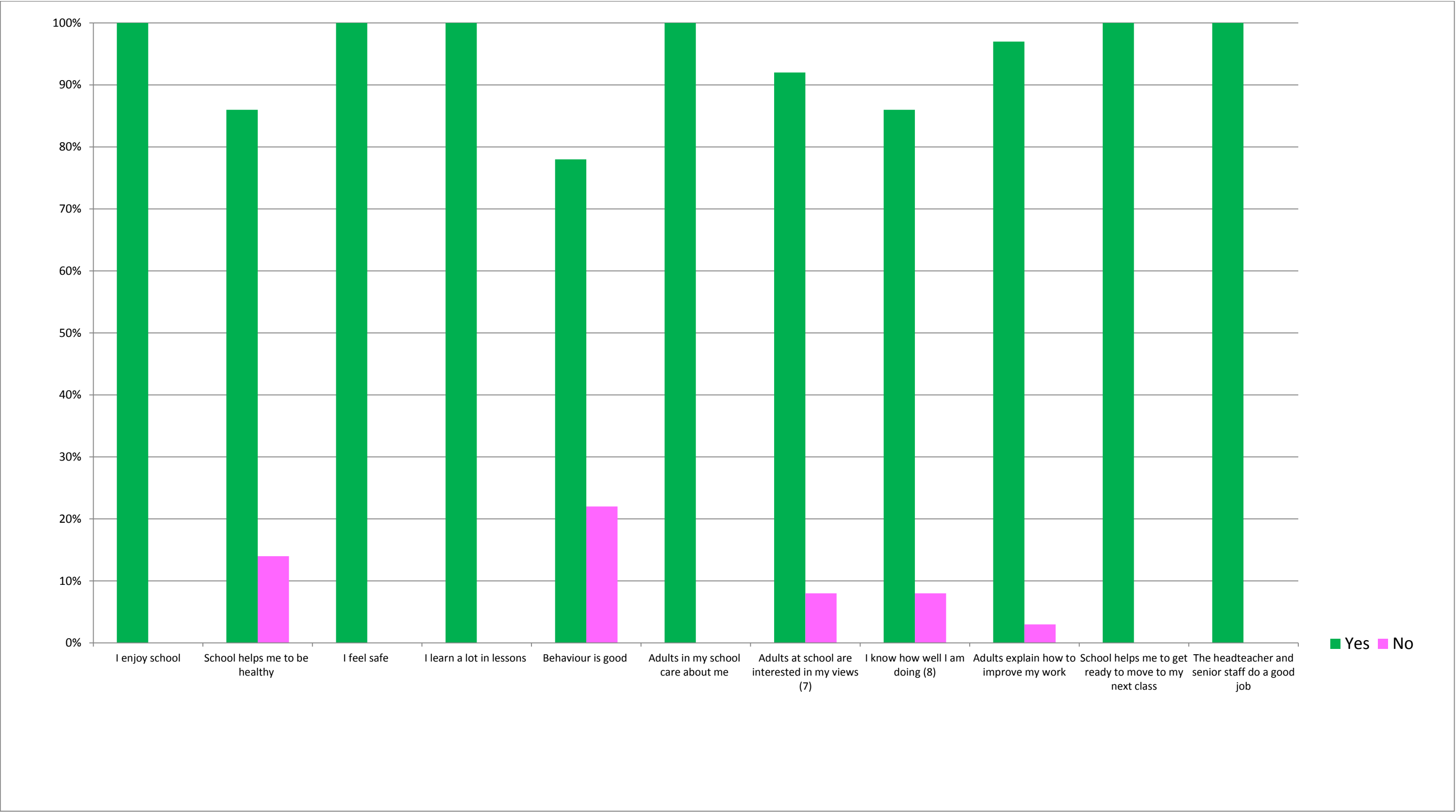


What pupils think about their school – we did a questionnaire with our pupils in July 2016

This chart shows what they thought.



This is what has happened since then.

We discussed the results with pupils to make sure we understood what they felt.



Behaviour – all pupils agreed that rough play at break times was the behaviour that wasn't good at school, and not behaviour in class.

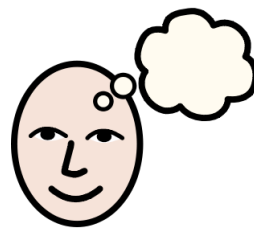


Mrs. Brett is checking playtimes to stop any rough play and staff will also be doing this.

Being healthy – after talking about what 'healthy' meant at school, children felt the school did help them to be healthy.



No. 7 - we all talked about what was meant by "my view". After discussion, pupils felt their views were listened to and there were times during the school day when their views would be heard.



No. 8 - some pupils had thought the question was asking how well they were doing. Children felt that they knew how they were doing by what staff said to them or wrote in their books.



Finally, older children would like to be able to add comments, rather than just a Yes or No answer in future.
