OPERATION ENCOMPASS

Our school participates in a national scheme called 'Operation Encompass', which is a joint partnership between the Police and schools. This system has been established to help schools provide in-school support to children who have been present at, exposed to or involved in any domestic abuse incident. As part of the Operation Encompass procedure, and to help mitigate the resulting negative impact, the school receives an email from the police the morning after a child has been witness to, or involved in, any reported domestic abuse incident. We are then able to use this information to provide the right support to any child and their family as and when it is needed.

Little Reminders

Please could you make sure that your child has their PE kit in school. For Health and Safety reasons the children need to be dressed in appropriate clothing when carrying out PE. Please also remember that reading folders need to be in school every day.
