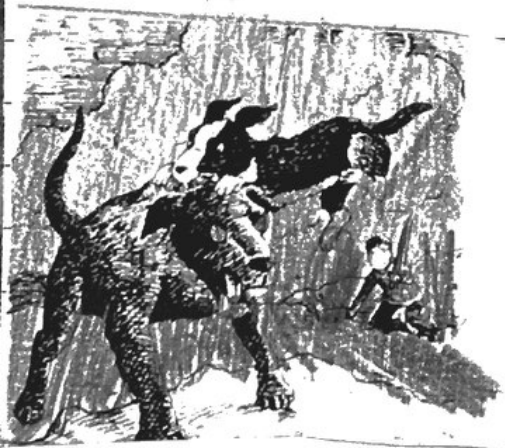
In this picture Oliver and Flow are walking on the Fells on a very misty day. Then the Tyson sheep came running up the Fells.
