Commentary:

After analysing the responses, the findings were discussed with the pupils to clarify their understanding.

*Statement 3 – Two children said they sometimes feel less safe at playtime, but they did feel safe at school.

Statement 5 – This was a really surprising response and highlighted how the children interpret teacher comments to pupils in lessons. The following was discussed:

- Some children may need 'prompting' to keep on task and complete work this does not mean that their behaviour is not good.
- Teachers are able to teach and pupils are able to learn; low level disruption is extremely rare.
- Most pupils display 'good behaviour for learning' and produce excellent work.
