Something to think about over Summer ...

For Children who will be Year 2 in September 2022

Reading

If you read for just 20 minutes a day, then you will learn more than 2 million words per year! Sharing stories with adults and your brothers and sisters, or reading alone each day has many benefits. Remember that books don't necessarily have to be school books; you can read a wide range of other things too - magazines, signs on television, labels on shopping, whatever you are interested in. Along with reading for pleasure, you could keep a diary or log of what you have been reading. Listening to stories is also fabulous! Ask your adults at home to read you stories or make up stories to tell you.

In the Autumn Term, 2022 we will be exploring the following topics so over the summer it would be helpful if you could carry out the following tasks ...

English- In the Autumn term we will be looking at labels and captions.

When you are out and about, can you see any labels anywhere? Maybe an adult could take a photo and you could bring it in to school. Can you read any labels around you? Can you write some captions to describe items your house?

Maths - In maths this term we will be counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's from zero so you could practice this at home. You could also practice counting in 10's from any number.



Geography

In Geography we will begin by looking at the 7 continents of the world. Can you name them?

Which one is the biggest? Which one is the smallest? How many people live in Europe?

You could find out the answers to these questions and even make up some more of your own.



History

In history we will be looking at toys from the past. Maybe you could look into these and possibly ask any older relatives what they used to play with when they were small? Can you write about what you found out?
